May 29th, 2020 - taking a closer look at family engagement as an intervention in substance use disorders the clinician should engage the patient s family and friends in forming a crisis plan for example a crisis plan for a person who abuses opioids should include education and naloxone particularly for those with a high risk of reattempting suicide via opioid overdose'

diagnosis while patient is intoxicated or within 3 4 weeks of
substance use or withdrawal management verify drug free state
with laboratory tests and assess psychiatric status when sober
obtain a careful longitudinal history tracking both substance use
and psychiatric symptoms track'**
