*May 24th, 2020 - the pass is not however the high point on trail ridge road which crests at 12,183 ft 3,713 m east of the pass within rocky mountain national park along with the rest of trail ridge road the pass is generally closed in winter from the first heavy snow fall usually october until the opening of the road around memorial day'*
