June 3rd, 2020 - the spanish government made wellington mander in chief of all allied armies providing an extra 21 000 spanish troops after salamanca although not pletely undefeated he never lost a major battle his greatest defeat came at the siege of burgos in 1812 where he had hoped to prevent french forces concentrating after losing 2 000 men and causing only 600 french casualties he was forced'
