June 3rd, 2020 - early trade unionism skilled workers in britain began anising themselves into trade unions in the 17th century preceded by guilds in medieval times during the 18th century when the industrial revolution prompted a wave of new trade disputes the government introduced measures to prevent collective action on the part of workers''**britain at work 1945 1995 union history**

June 4th, 2020 - in 1946 british union membership stood just under 9million and the percentage or density of those eligible to join trade unions was 43 this was a significant rise in density pared to 39 in 1945 reflecting male workers leaving the armed forces and entering employment following the end of the second world war''**a directory of british diplomats gulabin**

June 8th, 2020 - this directory includes senior british diplomats and other british civil servants working in a similar capacity who held posts overseas and in london it is confined to individuals who worked at counsellor assistant secretary grades and above the main part of the directory sections a d relates to the diplomatic service since 1789 and'
