June 1st, 2020 - regular munal jewish prayer began as a substitute for the sacrificial cult in the ancient temple in jerusalem the daily offerings there were acpanied according to later rabbinic sources by the recitation of biblical passages and extra biblical liturgies some psalms were perhaps sung in the temple by choirs of levites who aided the priests with the temple service'

*June 2nd, 2020 - prayer is an invocation or act that seeks to activate a rapport with an object of worship through deliberate munication in the narrow sense the term refers to an act of supplication or intercession directed towards a deity a god or a deified ancestor more generally prayer can also have the purpose of thanksgiving or praise and in parative religion is closely associated with more"***jesus prayer history amp practice britannica**

June 2nd, 2020 - jesus prayer also called prayer of the heart in eastern christianity a mental invocation of the name of jesus christ considered most efficacious when repeated continuously the most widely accepted form of the prayer is lord jesus christ son of god have mercy on me it reflects the biblical idea that the name of god is sacred and that its invocation implies a direct meeting with the'
