*June 2nd, 2020 - the history of Alaska dates back to the upper Paleolithic period around 14,000 BC when foraging groups crossed the Bering Land Bridge into what is now western Alaska at the time of European contact by the Russian explorers the area was populated by Eskimo groups the name Alaska derives from the Aleut word *alaxsxaq* also spelled *alyeska* meaning mainland literally the object toward'*
