**May 31st, 2020 - a history of hasidism a mystical movement within eastern european judaism posted on the spread and fragmentation of the hasidic movement can be understood in the context of the economic and socio political crisis of the polish jewry in the first half known as the gaon talmud scholar of vilnius was the head of the so called "yivo hasidism**

**November 18th, 2019 - the mitnagdim realized that the hasidic movement would always be popular the leader of mitnagdim the vilna gaon died in 1797 they wanted to join together to fight a new jewish movement that encouraged jews to be less religious called the haskalah'**

**'ashkenazi hasidim**

June 2nd, 2020 - the leaders of the munity of the ashkenazi hasidim movement were descended from the kalonymos family of northern italy a family that had immigrated to germany in the 10th century and the abun family of france among others according to the sacred books they wrote at the close of the 10th century ashkenazi hasidicism was a social movement'

May 22nd, 2020 - rabbi elijah known as the gaon of vilna who was the outstanding rabbinic scholar of his time emerged from his cloistered existence to
