April 15th, 2020 - the battle of the hedgerows is the second battle in the allied campaign one of the conflicts that prised the battle of the hedgerows the capture of the town of saint lo was fought between july 9th and 24th 1944 after the success of the invasion of normandy allied forces quickly targeted several cities of the peninsula to cut off german support and retreat lines saint la was a"tanks in battle of normandy part i in 31 photographs
