May 9th, 2020 - strathaven central or strathaven ns 702 442 was a railway station on the darvel and strathaven railway serving the town of strathaven in south lanarkshire scotland the station opened as an extension of the line from stonehouse and in 1904 was connected with the hamilton and strathaven railway via a link to strathaven north it was renamed as strathaven a few months before closure'

May 19th, 2020 - dalsersf ns 78111 50938 was a railway station on the caledonian railway line from brocketsbrae to ferniegair merryton junction serving the village of dalsersf in south lanarkshire scotland it opened as ayr road in 1866 and was closed from january 1941 to may 1945 and closed permanently in 1951'

'Stevenston Moorpark Railway Station

May 13th, 2020 - history the station opened on 3 September 1888 and was simply known as Stevenston it closed between 1 January 1917 and 1 February 1919 due to wartime economy and upon the grouping of the L&NWR into the London Midland and Scottish Railway in 1923 the station was renamed Stevenston Moorpark on 2 June 1924 the station closed to passengers on 4 July 1932 however it was reopened for a time"**lost rails herts memories**

June 2nd, 2020 - lost rails between 1838 and 1850 three of Britain's first mainline railways had crossed Hertfordshire on the way from London to distant cities Victorian railway mania was in full cry but Hertfordshire had few stations to show for the disruption to its countryside'
