in 875 ce on the nearby isle of may where vikings rampaged his monastery now an archaeological site a cairn where medieval pilgrims deposited some 1'

April 22nd, 2020 - caiplie house is named after caiplie caves situated a short distance along the coast to the west of crail they are well worth a visit the red sandstone was cut out by waves in post glacial times when the lower raised beach was being formed'
