March 28th, 2020 - cross tracks diversionary tracks which intersect the primary track in tracking tests cross tracks are laid deliberately to test the dog's ability to discriminate between the right scent and other scents in training and in tests animals and people sometimes provide unplanned cross tracks"tracking tools for beginners k9rally

June 2nd, 2020 - when first laying tracks let your dog watch you by crating him or tying him to a tree if you are with another person that person can hold your dog but should not distract or talk to the dog if you are with your instructor your instructor will lay your track'

June 3rd, 2020 - in addition to footstep tracking ipo dogs are required to track with a deep nose this means that the dog's nose is deep into the terrain and the dog's body language shows intensity and concentration throughout the track i actually have the confidence to go out in the field and lay an ipo track several times a week for my puppy he'

May 11th, 2020 - but if your dog speeds down the track take a look at the way you lay your tracks first before making any training decisions 3 create a calm start many dogs that struggle with speed pletely blow through their starts it may take them 50 paces or more to settle into the track and get into a tracking rhythm'

May 29th, 2020 - track your puppy on all kinds of terrain and across pathways introduce corners and serpentines and get a friend to lay cross tracks while your puppy still has food in every step this is an excellent time to introduce all the possibilities he may meet later in his tracking career'

June 6th, 2020 - for the beginner level or tracking dog td title the dog must follow a track 440 to 500 yards long with three to five turns and aged 30 minutes to two hours at the end he must indicate a scent article such as a glove to the handler'

June 2nd, 2020 - a dog must have attained the title of tracking champion prior to being eligible for entry into track and search dog trials a dog must be a minimum of twelve 12 months of age to enter in a track and search trial"tracking faq american kennel club

May 23rd, 2020 - an experienced tracklayer or akc judge will lay a regulation td track for your dog to follow after successfully pleting the track while under the observation of the judge the judge will'
