May 28th, 2020 - nurses are increasingly confronted with situations of moral difficulty such as not to feed terminally ill patients whistle blowing or participation in termination of pregnancy most of these moral dilemmas are often analyzed using the principle based approach which applies the four moral principles of justice autonomy beneficence and non malifcence in some instances consequentialism'
